GENERAL INFORMATION

NEW MEXICO NON-RESIDENT LICENSE FEES:

ANTELOPE: \$285 - BEAR: \$260 - DEER: \$270 - MOUNTAIN LION: \$290

ELK: \$547 to \$772 - IBEX: \$1616 - TURKEY: \$110

Habitat Improvement and deperdation stamps are required for most New Mexico hunts, total stamp cost is \$11

TEXAS NON-RESIDENT LICENSE FEES:

Small Game (Javalina and exotics) - \$48

Spring Turkey - \$126

General Hunting (Deer or Antelope) - \$315

A 6.0625% sales tax is added to the New Mexico hunt costs.

Hunters under 18 years of age require a hunter safety card.

For one guide per one hunter, add \$175 per day.

Balance is due 45 days before the start of the hunt.
